



Kansas Special Health Care Needs DECISION SCHEMA

Follow these steps to determine if a child is medically eligible for the Special Health Care Needs (SHCN) Program.

Children receiving KanCare may still qualify for the Special Health Care Needs Program.

Has the child received a diagnosis? —> Yes —> See qualifying conditions at www.kdheks.gov/shcn or below steps.
 —> No —> Refer to SHCN for One-Time Diagnostic.



What if...

Child's primary diagnosis is Autism, child also has seizure disorder

While Autism is not a SHCN medically eligible condition, seizure disorder is. Even though seizures are not the child's primary condition, the child would still be eligible for the SHCN program.

Child has developmental delay, child also has asthma

Neither of these conditions are qualifying conditions. Do not refer.
